

Proper Prescription Medication Disposal

As more and more people are prescribed medication, concern is growing as the need for safe disposal increases. Experts have expressed concerns about trace amounts of medications entering local waterways potentially harming fish and other wildlife; escaping water treatment plants untreated; and ending up in the wrong hands. Do NOT flush any drugs down the toilet. Instead, residents should seek proper disposal facilities or collection events.

Several agencies in Wood County offer free safe disposal locations for residents. Anyone may drop off unwanted, unused prescription drugs at these locations.

Please Note: *The following cannot be accepted at these locations: liquids; plastics; glass; bio-hazards; radioactive waste; syringes; drug paraphernalia or other medical waste.*
